Beware of scammers





Be Wise to Fraudsters!! Recent Fraud Scam targeting older residents



On a number of Boroughs since mid-March, the following scam/fraud has been attempted a number of times:

One or two white males – often reported to have Irish accent(s) have told older residents that urgent work is needed to be done on internal or external plumbing or that scaffolding work for roof repairs is urgently needed

In all cases, one of the men asks the resident for his phone number so his "boss" can ring to discuss. Then another male or same male using a different accent - says money needs to be paid to a courier who will attend or to the men who will attend to do the work.

Watch out for:

Often the contractor claims to be from "Dyno-Rod" but NO I.D is shown and not asked for by the resident.

Water is often splashed around to "prove" a leak.

Advice:

Always check with your utility supplier/Council !!

Never be pressured to let a stranger in to your home or to pay/get them any money!

Never be rushed into anything! Consider checking with a relative or friend you trust first!!

Ask questions! In doubt? Urgent? call police 999! Please do report incidents (use 101) / try to record any vehicle registrations used by "bogus" callers.
